

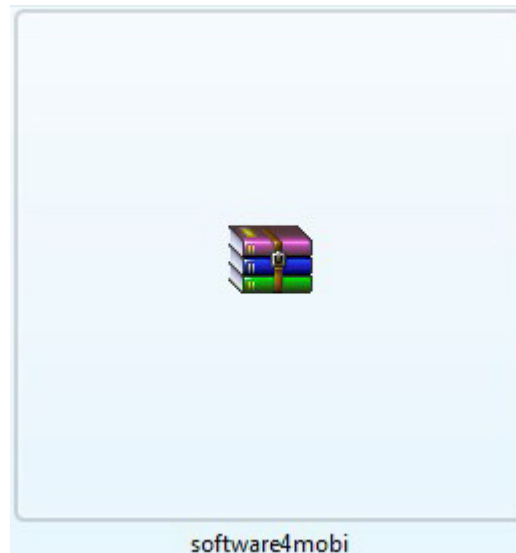

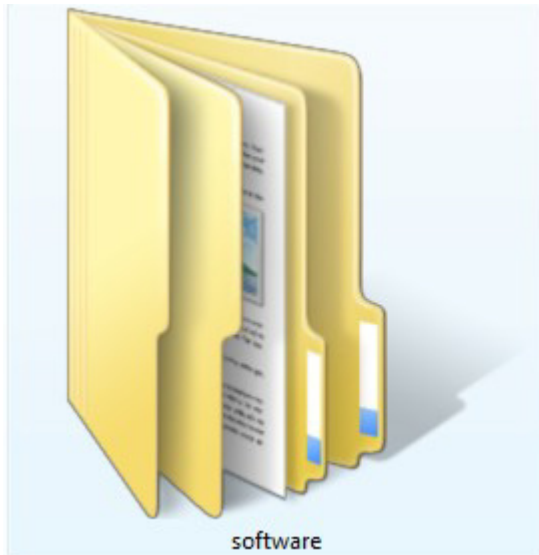

In Just Minutes

Download our free software and open the zip file with a program like winzip.
Most computers have already a program installed to open zip files.

Search on Google for winzip and zip files if you need a program to open zip files.



Open the folder “software4.mobi” and you will see a folder called “software” and a HTML document. Double click the html document to open locally in your browser. You will be able to access this video guide and additional information about our software.

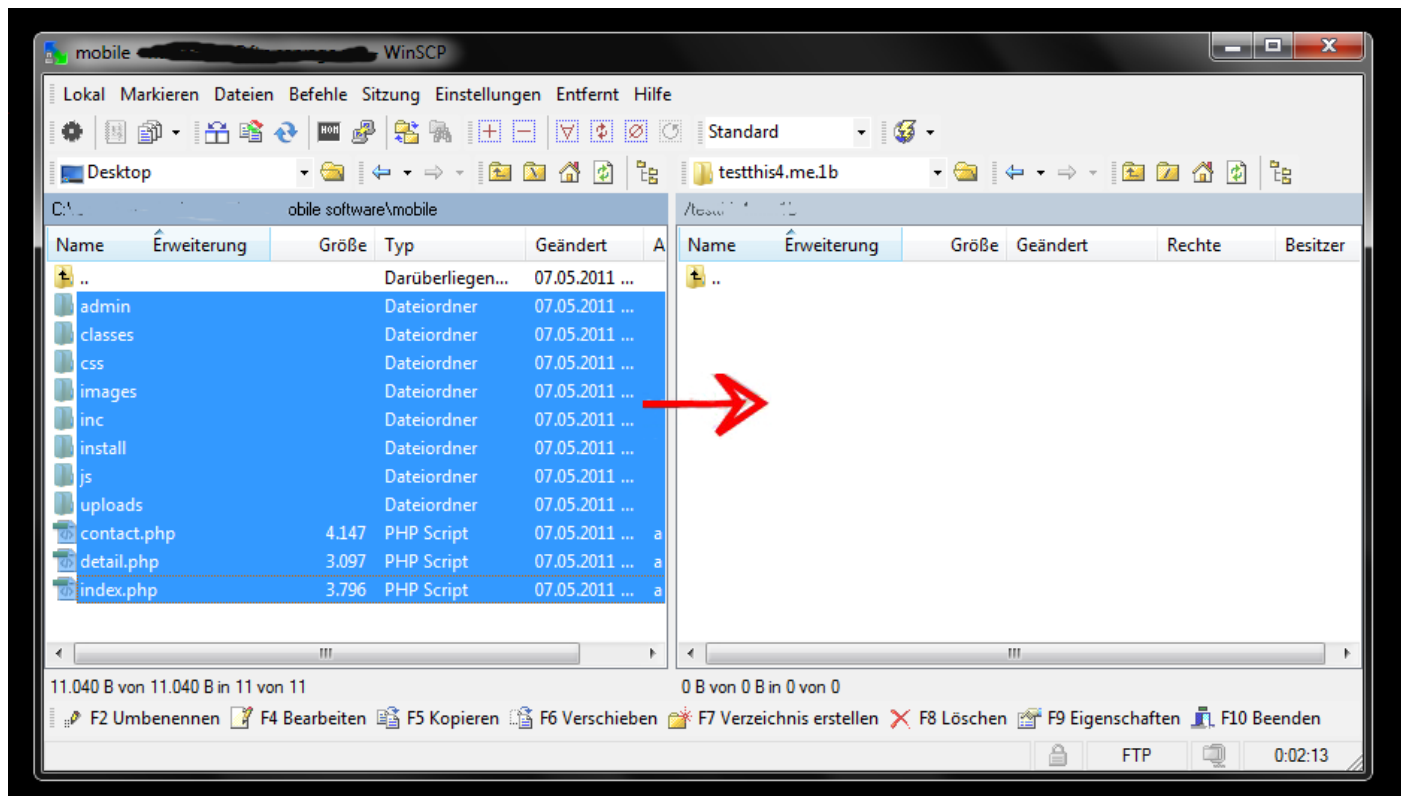


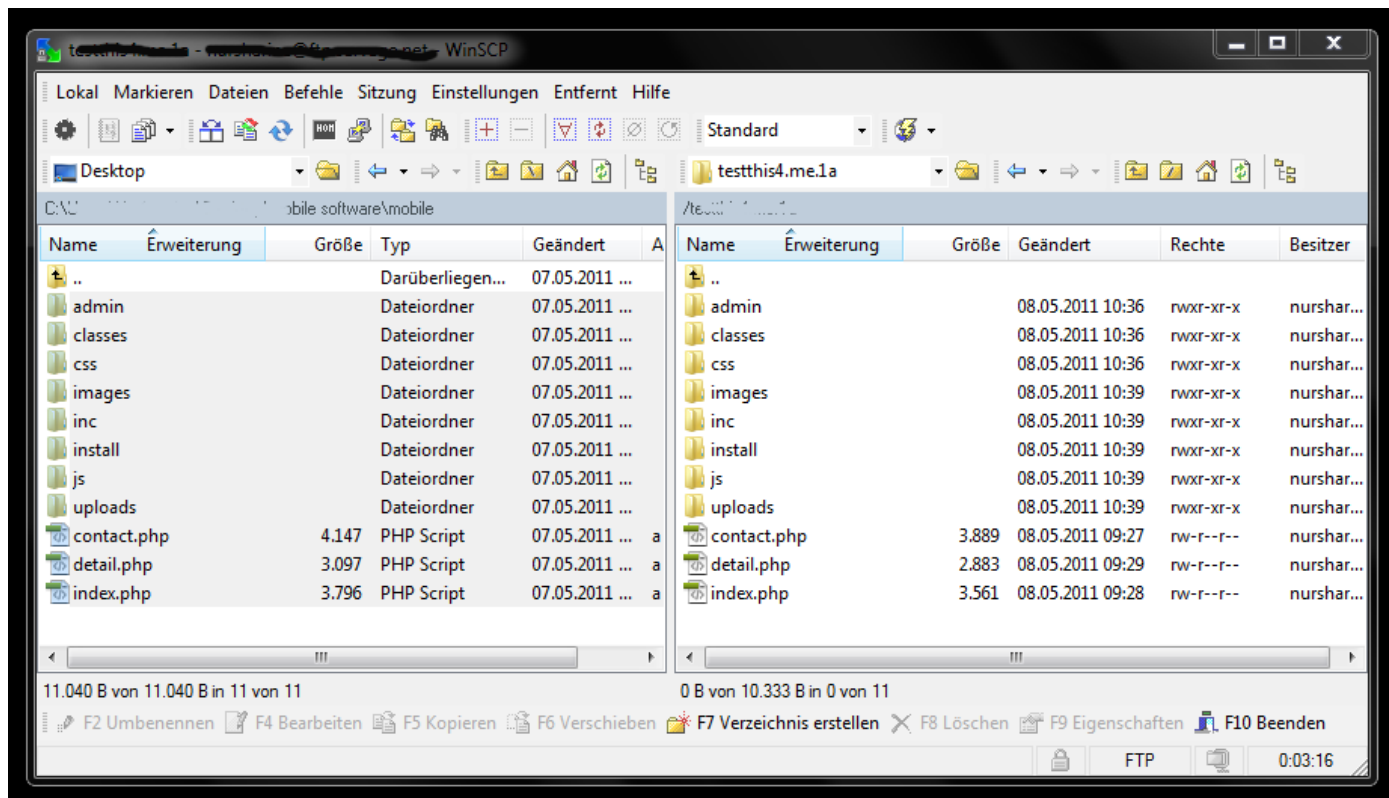
Now open the folder “software” and upload all of its content to your web space. You can upload the software in the root of any domain or sub domain or in a folder you create for it.

In our demonstration we upload the software to a sub domain where we usually host our mobile websites on (sub domain like m.youdomain.com – m. is very common to host mobile websites on – see m.facebook.com, m.youtube.com etc.)

Your hosting company will be able to answer all your questions in regards to sub domains and help you with setting one up.

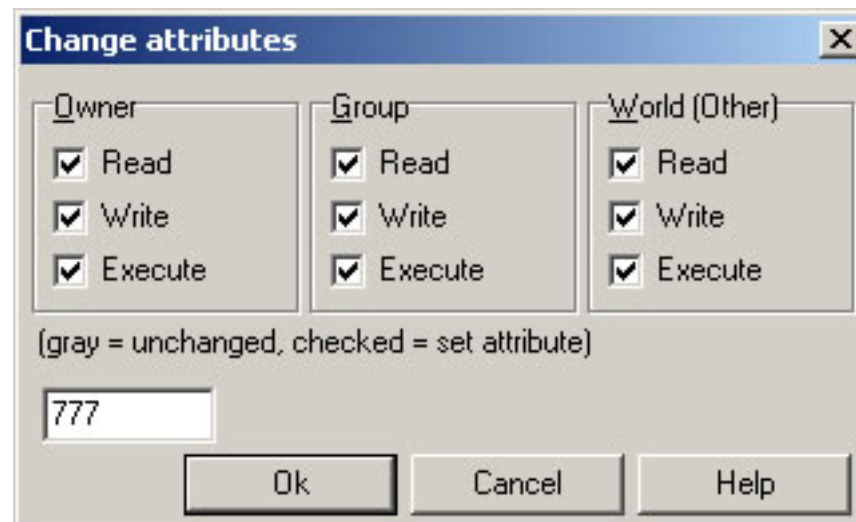
For the upload we use win-S-C-P a free program similar to other free ftp programs like filezilla and smartftp. You can download such ftp programs from the internet for free. Search Google for free ftp programs.





Once the software is fully uploaded you need to set permissions for the “upload” folder and the two subfolders within the upload folder. Set permissions to 777.

Your hosting company will be able to help you with any additional information on file settings and permissions you might need and guide you through the process of it if need be.

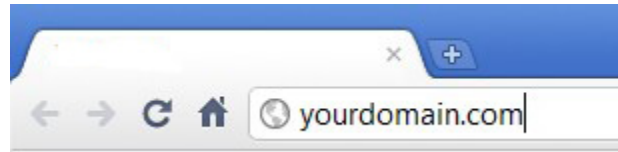


Now log on to your hosting account or C Panel and create a MySQL Database. You will need to take note of the Database Name, User, Host and Password.

Your hosting company will be able to help you with any additional information on how to create a MySQL Database.

Now you are ready to install the software. Simply call up the URL you installed the software to in your browser.

The installation process of the software will automatically start.



Follow step by step the instructions on screen providing the details of your My SQL Database, your E-Mail, Username, Password and any other information that is required.

Finally you click the install button and your software is installed.

Create Configuration File

Welcome to MOBILE SITE. Before getting started, we need some information on the database. You will need to know the following items before proceeding.

1. Database name
2. Database username
3. Database password
4. Database host


If for any reason this automatic file creation doesn't work, don't worry. All this does is fill in the database information to a configuration file. You may also simply open `admin/includes/dbconfig.php` in a text editor, fill in your information, and save it.

If you're all ready...






Upon the successful install of the software you need to delete the “install” folder from your web space.
